A JOURNEY OF FAITH to the Bible Lands ISRAEL & JORDAN

FEBRUARY 27 – MARCH 13, 2010



FEBRUARY 27 -

Depart Portland with Delta flight #1538 nonstop to Atlanta, leaving at 11:40AM and arriving at 7:21PM. Connect with Delta flight #152 nonstop to Tel Aviv, leaving at 10:40PM.

FEBRUARY 28 - TIBERIAS (D)

Arrive Tel Aviv at 4:25PM. Upon arrival, you will be met at the airport by a Ya'lla Tours USA Israel representative and transferred to your hotel for dinner and overnight. RON BEACH is a tourist class hotel, located only 10 minutes walking distance from downtown Tiberias, with a private beach. www.ronbeachhotel.com

MARCH 01 - TIBERIAS (B,D)

Drive to the ruins of Caesarea, a large port city built by Herod the Great to honor Caesar Augustus. In order to supply water to the city's ever-growing population, he built an aquaduct system from the springs of Mt. Carmel to Caesarea. Part of this system is still visible today. The book of Acts refers repeatedly to Caesarea as the city Peter visited (Acts 10). Continue to Mt. Carmel and the Carmelite Monastery of Muhraka, where God caused Elijah to defeat the priests of Ba'al. On to Megiddo, the "Hill of Battles," where archaeologists have uncovered 20 civilizations built one upon another. At this site, King Solomon built his vast stables and good King Josiah died in battle. Look over the peaceful Jezreel Valley. Arrive Tiberias for dinner and overnight.

MARCH 02 - TIBERIAS (B,L,D)

Take a private boat on the Sea of Galilee to see the Genosar Boat, a 1st century fishing boat discovered in 1986 when the lake receded to record low levels. Visit Capernaum where Jesus preached, and his disciples, Peter, Andrew, and perhaps others, made their homes. Travel up the Mount of Beatitudes, site of the Sermon on the Mount and the Miracle of the Fishes. The contemporary church at Tabga celebrates the Miracle of the Multiplication. Note the mosaic floor from a Byzantine-era church, and the section in front of the ancient altar depicting two fish and a basket

filled with loaves of bread. Lunch on St. Peter's Fish at Kibbutz Hagoshrim. Then, at a unique location on the River Jordan, we will remember our own baptism. Next, drive to the Upper Galilee to Banias (Caesarea Philippi) to see the source of the Jordan River and the site of Peter's confession, "...you are the Christ" (Matt. 16:18). Return to Tiberias for dinner and overnight.

MARCH 03 - TIBERIAS (B,D)

Visit the Church of the Transfiguration atop Mt. Tabor and enjoy an outstanding view of the Jezreel Valley where the battle of Deborah and the Midianites took place (Judges 5). Continue to Tzipori to see the ruins of a Galilean Village from the days of Jesus. Stop at Cana and then continue on to Nazareth, where our Lord spent most of his life. Today, Nazareth is home to the largest Arab population in Israel. Visit the Church of the Annunciation and St. Joseph's Grotto. End the day with a visit to the Nazareth Village and experience the way of life in the Galilee in the days of Jesus. Return to Tiberias for dinner and overnight.

MARCH 04 - PETRA (B,L,D)

Drive to the northern border crossing between Israel & Jordan. In Jordan, you will met by a Ya'lla Tours USA representative and your Jordanian tour guide. First, visit the site widely believed to be Bethany Beyond the Jordan, where Jesus was baptized. Enjoy lunch by the Dead Sea. Then on to Mt. Nebo, the traditional site of the tomb of Moses overlooking the Jordan Valley and the Dead Sea. Continue to Petra for dinner and overnight. CROWNE PLAZA PETRA RESORT is a 4-star property located only steps away from the visitor's entrance to the Siq and the ancient site of Petra.

MARCH 05 - PETRA (B,D)

Tour the city of Petra. Travel on horseback to the Siq (canyon), and then on foot to Petra. Known as the *Red Rock City*, Petra was the capital of the Nabateans from the 3rd century B.C. to the 2nd century A.D. Petra's most elegant monument, The Treasury, comes dramatically into view as you emerge from the Siq.



MARCH 09 - JERUSALEM (B,D)
 Visit the House of Caiaphas, chief priest of the Jews, and see the dungeon where Jesus was held prior to his trial. Enter the Jewish quarter of the Old City and see the Burnt House and the Herodian Quarter, vivid reminders of the Roman destruction of the city and Temple in 70 A.D. Walk down to the Western Wall, the only visible remains of the Second Temple and the holiest site in Judaism. See the Temple Steps, the original set of fifteen steps leading to the Temple's Entrance to the Court of the Israelites. Then visit the Davidson Center and view a multi-media presentation about Jerusalem in the days of Jesus. Next, walk through the Western Wall Tunnel, huge arched spaces just north of the Western Wall. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

Beyond The Treasury, an entire city is carved into the canyon walls. Wander through the field of tombs and obelisks to the Altar. From this point you can view the whole of the rock city. The most adventurous will be invited to hike up to the spiritual High Place, offering a spectacular view of the ancient city and surroundings. Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

MARCH 06 - AQABA (B,L,D)
 Drive to Wadi Rum and take a short 4X4 vehicle ride into the oasis with its awesome moon-like landscape. The film Lawrence of Arabia was shot here. Enjoy a Bedouin lunch with the locals, in the tradition of the Patriarchs. Then drive to the Red Sea resort of Aqaba for some free time by the sea, dinner and overnight. MARINA PLAZA is a nice 4-star property located in the bustling marina area of Tala Bay, 18km from Aqaba. www.marinaplaza.org

MARCH 08 - JERUSALEM (B,D)
 The morning is at leisure. After noon, drive to Masada. Take the cable car to the top of the rock and visit the Roman palaces, store houses, synagogues and bath house which witnessed the Jewish resistance to the Romans approximately 2,000 years ago. Descend by cable car and visit Qumran, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found in 1947. Then drive up into the Judean Hills and the most beautiful city in the world, JERUSALEM, for dinner and overnight. DAN PANORAMA JERUSALEM is a moderate 4.5 star hotel within easy walking distance of the Old City and downtown Jerusalem. www.danhoteles.com

MARCH 07 - DEAD SEA (B,D)
 Cross back to Israel and drive through the Arava Valley to the lowest place on

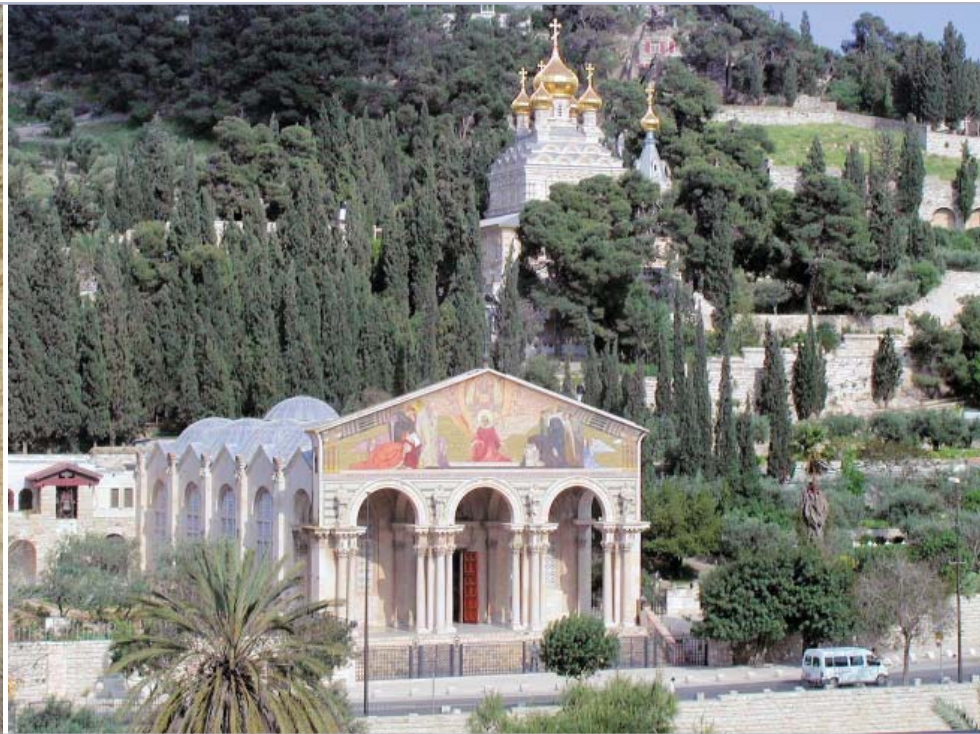
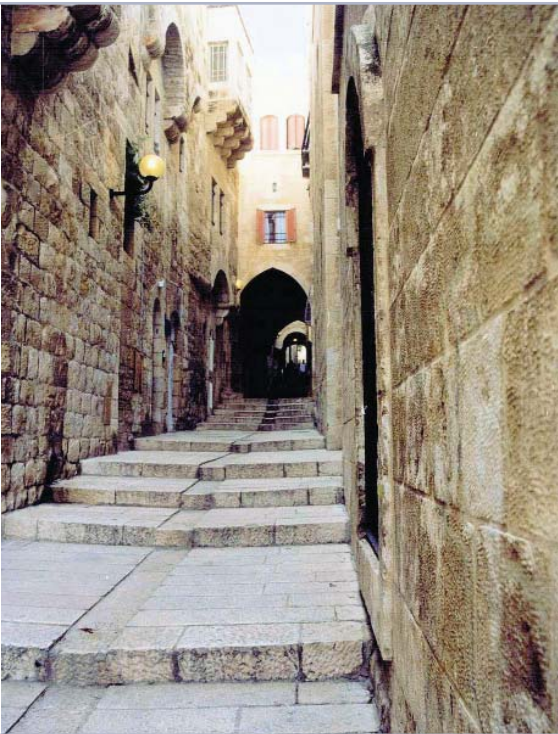


Garden of Gethsemane

MARCH 10 - JERUSALEM (B,D)
 Drive 6 miles south to Bethlehem and visit the Church of the Nativity, the oldest church in the holy land still in use. Sing carols in a site that has been visited by millions of pilgrims. Return to Jerusalem and visit the Shrine of the Book to glimpse fragments of the Dead Sea Scrolls and see the Model of ancient Jerusalem. Finally today, tour Yad Vashem Holocaust Memorial and attend a memorial service there. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

MARCH 11 - JERUSALEM (B,D)
 Drive to the Mount of Olives for a panoramic view of Jerusalem. Walk down the Mount of Olives and stop at the Church of Pater Noster, on the site where Jesus was inspired with the Our Father prayer, and the Church of Dominus Fleuit (Jesus Wept). The Garden of Gethsemane lies at the foot of the Mount of Olives. Today it appears much as it did 2,000 years ago. Originally built in 379 A.D., the Church of Gethsemane was rebuilt in 1919 - 1924 and is known as the Church of all Nations because 16 nations contributed to its construction. Enter the Christian Quarter of the Old City through Stephen's Gate. See the Pool of Bethesda, where Jesus healed the blind man, and St. Anne's Church. Walk the Way of the Cross, the Via Dolorosa, and stop at Lutheran Church of the Redeemer. If you like, climb the bell tower for a fantastic view of the Old City. Continue walking to the Church of the Holy Sepulcher. In 325, Constantine's mother Helen had a church built on this spot. The 4th century church was largely destroyed by the Turks in 1009 and partially restored in 1048.

Then, visit the Garden Tomb, believed by many Protestant denominations to be the location of Jesus' burial. We will have time for prayer and meditation and Holy Communion.

MARCH 12 - JERUSALEM (B,D)
 Drive to the ancient port of Joppa (Jaffa) where Peter raised Tabitha from the dead and Jonah had his encounter with the whale. Stroll the cobblestone streets, now filled with boutiques and galleries. Continue to the Nachlat Yehuda pedestrian mall and arts and crafts market held every Friday. Return to Jerusalem for a Shabbat farewell dinner and time to relax until your departure. You will be transferred to the airport around 8:00PM for your nonstop, nonsmoking Delta Airlines flight #153 to Atlanta, leaving at 11:25PM.

MARCH 13 -
 Arrive Atlanta at 5:40AM. Clear US Customs and Immigration and connect with Delta nonstop flight #1761 to Portland, leaving at 8:40AM and arriving at 10:50AM.
